RE: Annual Appropriations Requests

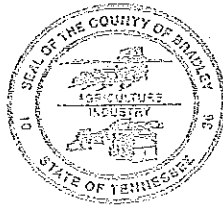
Each year, Senators Lamar Alexander and Bob Corker and US Representative Zach Wamp contact my office regarding the County's Appropriations requests from the Federal Government. Congressman Wamp is the only one who asks for a resolution supporting the County's requests.

As in years past we have mirrored the City of Cleveland's financial requests and are doing so this year in an effort to maximize the potential of getting our requests approved.

The top three requests for funding are:

1. 1-75 Exit 20 bridge and interchange improvements (\$13,000,000)
2. APD-40 Interchange (\$13,000,000)
3. APD-40 Frontage and Connector Road System on North and South sides (\$8,000,000)

There seems to be general agreement that these three connected projects are essential to future economic development.

2. APD-40 Interchange
3. APD-40 Frontage and Connector Road System on North and South sides

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the County Mayor is asked to submit information on the aforementioned projects to Congressman Wamp for his assistance and support.
