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Quality Correctional Health Care (QCHC) is pleased to make the following proposal to the Bradley County Jail for their inmate healthcare. Renewal date 7/1/10.

All services will remain the same as the current contract.

- 1) Staffing
 - a. Nursing coverage 24/7 with LPN's and 1 FTE RN
 - b. Physician – Nurse Practitioner onsite 1 day week
- 2) Dental Services provided onsite (\$10,000 cap)
- 3) Laboratory Services
- 4) Biohazard waste disposal
- 5) Radiology Services provided on site for routine Chest X-rays and non-emergent extremity
- 6) Electronic pharmacy system including all formulary pharmaceuticals with exception of Chemotherapy Drugs, HIV Medication, Atypical Antipsychotic, Hepatitis and Dialysis. These would be provided out of the aggregate pool until exhausted, at which time the county would be billed for the cost.
- 7) All medical supplies
- 8) All office supplies
- 9) Mental Health via tele-video
- 10) Electronic Medical Record System
- 11) Training for Correctional Officers
- 12) 3 million/5 million Medical Malpractice liability coverage
- 13) 24 hour physician on-call availability
- 14) Hospital services and off site visits to be provided out of an aggregate cap of \$75,000 annually. Once aggregate cap is exhausted the County will be responsible for offsite visits; payable 30 days from time services are rendered.
- 15) **Refund of unused pool money:** Ninety (90) days after the end of the previous year's contract, any remaining balance in the aggregate cap will be deducted from the overall cost of the current year's contract. This will allow time for all charges to come in from the previous year.

SAVINGS FROM MULTI-YEAR CONTRACT

- 1 Year Contract: Current Contract Price (\$631,186.40) + current medical CPI
- 2 Year Contract: Year 1 Contract Price + current medical CPI minus 1 percent
- 3 Year Contract: Year 2 Contract Price + current medical CPI minus 2 percent

**CPI will be calculated using the calendar year
